UCM End of Year Bash and Steam-UP **Saturday, May 26**

This year UCM will return to the Southern Ontario Steam Engine Museum for its final "meeting". We will meet at Larry and Susan Martin's home at 10:15 AM, then:

- Travel one kilometre to the Museum, where
- Owner (and fountain of knowledge about all things steam) Wayne Fischer will give us a guided tour of his museum – including about 15 Steam Traction Engines (Tractors) from the early 1900's, steam locomotive, several functioning turbines, and various wood splitters and saws
- If there are 20 or more, Wayne will fire up one of the engines for a ride through his 232 acre woodland.
- At noon, after the tour, we will return to Larry and Susan's for steamed mussels (in white wine), beef barbeque and whatever else Chef Randy dreams up.
- Of course there will be a healthy supply of Taps Brewing company's Charleston Lager, Red Cream Ale and Sinister Sam IPA to sip on the deck and in the garden.

This is a great event for kids and grandkids. Everyone is welcome, including men who don't regularly attend UCM, and women who want to learn about steam!!

As usual admission will be \$25 with beer, \$20 without beer, Kids \$5. As always, any surplus will be donated to Wesley.
